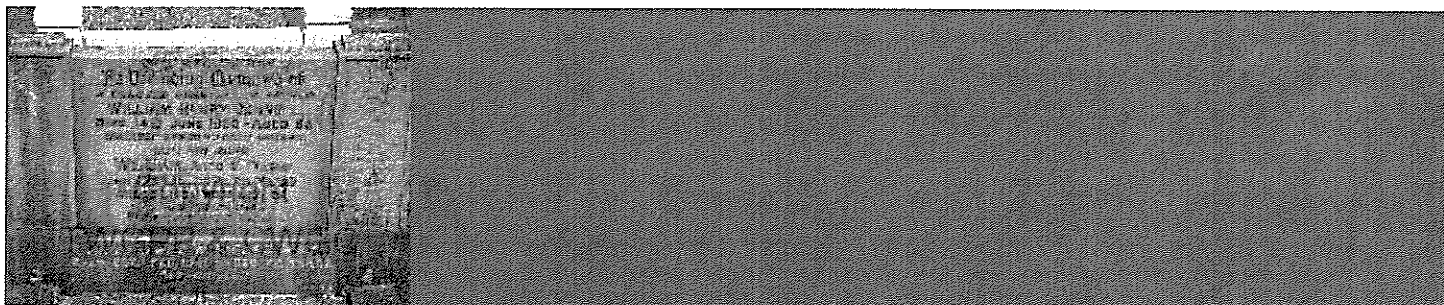

On March 25th (according to some sources the 29th), the Calvi intercepted and sank the British cargo ship TREDINNICK of 4,589 T.S.L. This ship was built in 1921 by the shipyard "J Readhead & Son Ltd" of South Shields and belonged to the "J Readhead & Son Ltd" with offices in London and Cardiff. The sinking took place in position 27° 15'N 49° 15'W and none of the 46 crewmembers were rescued.
